INTRODUCTION

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Government College Kattappana functions to develop and implement action plans to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution. The college formulates plans and policies for academic progression and administrative reforms after making careful study and analysis of the needs and requirements of the college and taking into consideration the suggestions and opinions of all stakeholders such as faculty members, students, parents, staff and alumni.

Student feedback is an important input in formulating the quality improvement strategies of an educational institution. Therefore the IQAC of the college collects feedback from students every year and quality improvement measures are taken to address the concerns raised by students.

Beginning from 2014-15 onwards, the college has developed an online feedback system to collect feedback from students. The online feedback system has been developed by the college itself using the open source software *limesurvey* and is hosted on the college website *gckottayam.ac.in*. The online system helps the students to voice their opinions anonymously. It also makes the data collection and analysis paperless and environment friendly.

The feedback process is intended to collect the responses on the academic and administrative functioning of the college, the infrastructure and facilities, programmes of study and the performance of teachers.

The feedback is divided into three parts consisting of objective questions. The first part consists of questions regarding the overall functioning of the college such as the academic atmosphere, administrative services, classroom facilities, infrastructure etc.

The second part is an evaluation of the programme of study and the departments. Questions are framed to evaluate the value of the programme of study in preparing the student for employment and higher studies, the curricula, the teacher student relationship etc.

The third part is teacher evaluation. It is designed to evaluate parameters such as knowledge base of the teacher, communication skills, mentoring and helping mentality, regularity and punctuality etc.

In addition, the students are provided with an opportunity to express their general suggestions and opinions in a descriptive manner.

Feedback on each faculty member is confidentially communicated to the corresponding person.

A summary of evaluation about the college and departments are included in this report.

manner. Almost all final year students participated in the feedback process.

Major suggestions of students include

• New PG programmes may be started

• Skill development courses may be strengthened

• Soft skills training may be offered to all students

Placement activities may be strengthened

Canteen may be renovated

Sports facilities may be improved

• Coaching programmes may be made more effective

As can be inferred from the responses given in graphical and table form, the students

have positively rated the college and have a high opinion of the departments and faculty

members. However the students have mentioned areas where improvement is required.

The responses of students will be taken into account for the framing of quality

improvement measures by the IQAC.
