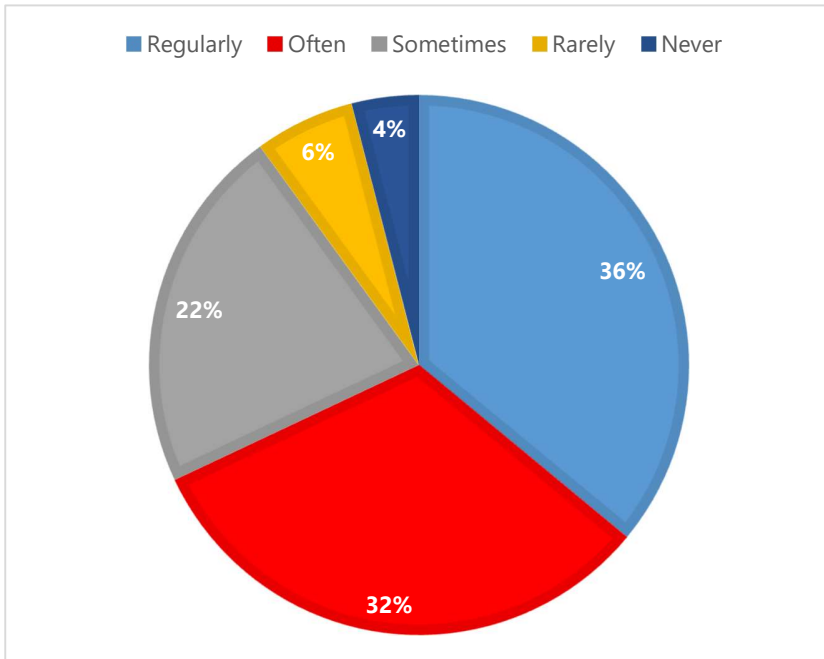
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers



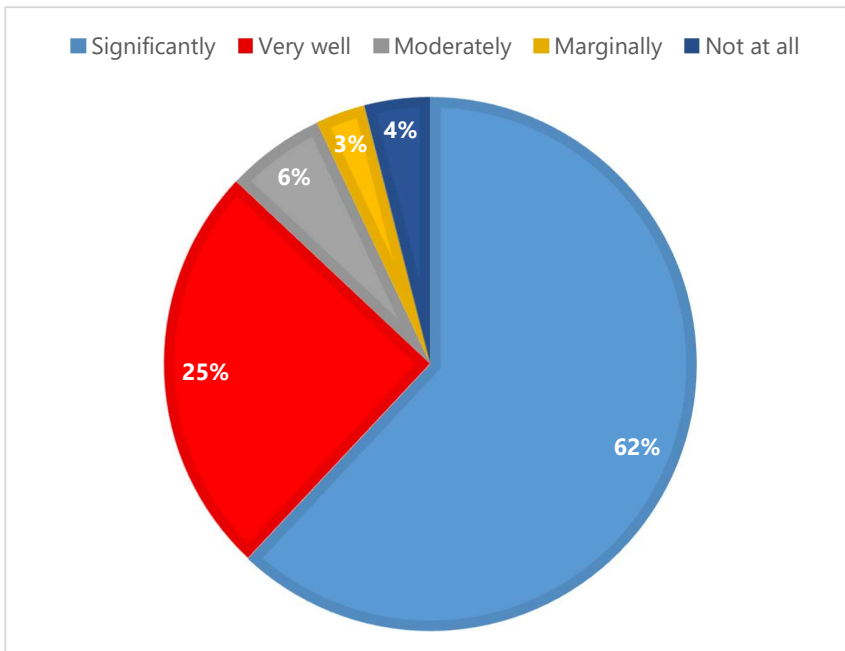
